3. Student's academic standing must be commensurate with his or her ability (attach transcript and/or mid term report). **SCHOLARSHIPS WILL ONLY BE AWARDED WITH PROOF OF ACCEPTANCE AT THE INSTITUTION SPECIFIED (University or College).**
4. The successful candidates must show leadership ability and commitment to their school and/or community.
5. A committee setup by the SMC alumni association will review the applications and select the successful candidates. This team may consult with school staff about the selections. The committee may also wish to meet with the successful candidates.
6. Applications must be received no later than **June 1, 2011** by Student Services at *St. Mary's College* or *St. Basil Secondary School* guidance offices.

After graduating from Law School, Carmen returned home to start his practice here and became the first President of the St. Mary's College Alumni Association where he was instrumental in organizing two Cottage Lottery Fundraisers that provide capital for the bursaries that we are proud to offer in his name.

Carmen's many accomplishments for the Sault Ste. Marie area and Canada are well known. He loved his community and its people and served selflessly to help them. In turn, the people have responded by naming a street “*Carmen's Way*” in his honour.

We at St. Mary's know of his love for his Alma Mater and the priests who helped form him. We return that love by offering this aid to our future generations in the name of one of St. Mary's most beloved sons.

- 2. The “Basilian” Award will be presented each year in the name of a Basilian Priest(s) who has served SMC since 1956. The awards will acknowledge our Founding Fathers, Father Matt Mulcahy & Father Pat Lalonde.**
